This scholarship is designed to reward students who have graduated from the University of Arizona Race Track Industry Program, University of Louisville Equine Industry Program, another equine related program, or want to pursue a career as a racing official. The purpose of these scholarships is to allow individuals the opportunity to pursue a career in the horse racing industry as a racing official. One \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded for the 2011 Racing Officials Accreditation School.

- Or show that you will make a contribution to the racing industry.
