



ROAP is pleased to introduce the Certificate Program. The goal of the ROAP Certificate Program is to provide an intermediary step toward full ROAP accreditation or to provide those who do not wish to be fully accredited shorter, job-specific courses that result in earning a racing official certificate. This will be the first available training program for hands on racing official training in the U.S.

The ROAP Certificate Program is a two-day program, consisting of one day of general education for all officials and one day of job-specific modules geared toward each specific racing official position. Each student will focus on one racing official training program. The program will be conducted at a racetrack to ensure the students receive hands-on experience in the environment in which they work.

The two-day course will conclude with a short examination and the granting of a certificate to those who complete the course and pass the examination. Students who complete the two-day course and pass the exam can come back and take additional modules/exams for up to two years without re-taking the general education day.

The racing officials' modules will consist of:

- Clerk of Scales
- Paddock Judge
- Starter / Assistant Starter
- Horse Identifier
- Patrol Judge / Placing Judge
- Outrider

Certificates are good for five years and cost per participant will be \$25.
